

Report of Pupils' Results at KS2

This report contains results from the formal SATs assessments as well as teacher assessments based on the new rigorous criteria published by the government. There is also a key to explain the various codes used to report the results, which may seem quite complicated. If you feel you would like further clarification, we have published on our website an additional document published by the Department for Education called 'Information for parents: 2016 national curriculum tests at the end of key stages 1 and 2' which explains the KS2 assessments in greater depth.

At a time when the expectations and challenge have been set far higher than previously, we have been so proud to see our pupils showing determination to succeed and master skills that seemed 'too hard' at first. We have been very impressed by the hard work and positive attitudes with which our Year 6 have approached these challenges and grateful for the support given at home.
