Information about pupils in schools, alternative provision, pupil referral units and children in early years settings

## Data Protection Act 1998: How we use pupil information

We collect and hold personal information relating to our pupils and may also receive information about them from their previous school, local authority and/or the Department for Education (DfE). We use this personal data to:

- support our pupils' learning
- monitor and report on their progress
- provide appropriate pastoral care; and
- assess the quality of our services

This information will include their contact details, national curriculum assessment results, attendance information, any exclusion information, where they go after they leave us and personal characteristics such as their ethnic group, any special educational needs they may have as well as relevant medical information.

A parent/guardian can request that **only** their child's name, address and date of birth be passed to Staffordshire Local Authority by informing the school office. This right is transferred to the child once he/she reaches the age 16. We will not give information about our pupils to anyone without your consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so.

We are required, by law, to pass some information about our pupils to organisations including our local authority (LA), the Department for Education (DfE), Entrust, Concero, The NHS & Ofsted. We may also share personal data with providers of services within or on behalf of the school (e.g. School Photographer, Parentpay and Teachers 2 Parents text messaging service, External Travel Providers

DfE may also share pupil level personal data that we supply to them, with third parties. This will only take place where legislation allows it to do so and it is in compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998.

Decisions on whether DfE releases this personal data to third parties are subject to a robust approval process and are based on a detailed assessment of who is requesting the data, the purpose for which it is required, the level and sensitivity of data requested and the arrangements in place to store and handle the data.

conditions covering the confidentiality and handling of data, security arrangements and retention and use of the data.
