Dear Parents/Carers

Year 8: Staffordshire Regiment Museum, Lichfield - Tuesday 28th & Wednesday 29th November 2017

I am delighted to inform you that we have arranged for Year 8 pupils to visit the Staffordshire Regiment Museum at Whittington Barracks near Lichfield. This trip forms part of their English studies this term, centred upon the war themed book *Private Peaceful* by Michael Morpurgo.

This opportunity will give your child a first-hand experience of what World War I was like on the battlefield and an opportunity to try on the clothes of a soldier, their weaponry and much more. Pupils will also explore the museum where they can see a large collection of artefacts from WWI.

On the day we will be departing from school around 9:15am and will return at 2:45pm. Pupils will need to wear school uniform and bring a packed lunch, a water bottle and a waterproof coat in case of poor weather. There will also be an opportunity to visit the gift shop where gifts and souvenirs can be purchased. Children are permitted to bring a maximum of £10 if they wish to buy something but must bring a wallet/purse with them.

Please be aware due to the restriction of the number of pupils at the venue, the trip will take place over two days. Therefore, there will be two tutor groups going on Tuesday and three tutor groups going on Wednesday, as detailed below.

Tuesday 28th November- 8RD, 8NC & half of 8EW Wednesday 29th November- 8LH, 8PG & half of 8EW

The pupils will be made aware of which day they will be attending.

The trip will involve a voluntary contribution of £10.00 per child for the visit to cover costs for the museum and transport. We would really appreciate your support with this and if we do not have enough contributions to cover the overall costs, we may have to cancel the visit.
