

Theatre Company Returns To Codsall Middle School!

Dear Parent/Carer

We are excited to launch our second Theatre Company at Codsall Middle School, commencing after October half term on Tuesday 6th November 2018.

The club will run from 3.30pm-5pm every Tuesday which will be run by Mrs Carey and Miss Jessop. We are still in negotiations regarding the chosen Musical and will update you as soon as it has been agreed, but it promises to be great!!

Children would be expected to commit to the club for a period of 18 weeks where they will learn all aspects of performance, including dancing, acting and singing. The sessions will have something to interest everyone.

We actively welcome both boys and girls to get involved and children should not feel that they have to be particularly gifted in all three areas of acting, dancing and singing. A willingness to have a go and commit to learning lines etc outside of rehearsals is also paramount.

Parts will be allocated through a non-stressful audition session led by Mrs Carey where children are observed and monitored. **Please note: not every child can be a lead character as of course parts are limited and for licensing reasons we must adhere to that.**

Sessions will cost £5 for the one and a half hour session and parents would be asked at this stage to pay £50.00 to pay for the first 10 sessions, with a further payment later on in the term with the remainder. Unfortunately we are unable to offer refunds if your child decides to leave the club due to upfront costs of licencing and legal fees.

At this stage we would just ask children to return the slip requesting their place and then once a space is confirmed via school text, we will request payment immediately via cash or cheque made payable to Emma Carey. If payment is not made within the first two weeks, the Theatre Company have the right to refuse your child attendance until arrears are settled.

Should your child be allocated space they will need to bring comfortable clothes and flat shoes (trainers/pumps etc) to the sessions as well as a drink and a snack.

Please note a prerequisite for your child's attendance at the club is an ability to follow instructions, a willingness to rehearse at home as well as in school and good behaviour. **Mrs Carey and the school reserve the right to withdraw provision**

if a child's behaviour compromises the enjoyment or progress of a club for other children. We would hope that this is never needed.
