Dear Parents/Carers

Year 6 Science Trip – Think-tank Museum, Birmingham.

To enrich our Science curriculum 6E, 6F and 6O will be visiting the Thinktank Museum Birmingham on **Wednesday 6th March**. It is an amazing museum which will really bring the Science in KS2 to life.

On the day pupils will be expected to arrive at school, in full uniform, at the normal time. We expect to arrive back at school before 3.15pm. Mobile phones will be collected in and given out as normal on return.

Your child will need a packed lunch (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles/chewing gum) in a carrier bag that can be later disposed of. Additionally, a coat is advisable. Pupils will be responsible for, and carrying, all their belongings (a small rucksack would be useful). They will be allowed to make purchases from the souvenir shop and should bring their own money if you wish them to do so, to the value of no more than £5.00.

The cost of the coach and entrance to the centre is £10.50. This is a voluntary contribution; however, the trip cannot take place unless we receive sufficient funds.

Payments are non-refundable and can be made using Parent Pay. I would be very grateful if you could do this before Friday 15th February so that I can confirm the booking.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals I will speak with them before hand to arrange for the school kitchen to provide sandwiches and a drink for them unless they wish to bring these from home themselves.
