This will take place in the school hall on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> April, at 4pm. It should last no longer than an hour and a half. Some of the event will be a talk from the people from Guide Dogs, and there will also be a raffle. We are hoping to raise as much money as possible, as we have learnt it takes a staggering £55,000 to train and support just one guide dog from puppy to retirement.

Entry will be on the door, with a suggested donation of £2 each. Please come with lots of pennies to support this very worthy cause!
