Performing Arts visit to London
Thursday 28th - Friday 29th March 2019

Please find below confirmation of the itinerary for the forthcoming residential visit to London.

Thursday 28th March

8.00am – Depart school. Please arrive no later than 7.45am.

11.00am – Arrive at Covent Garden

We will have approximately one and half hours for sightseeing and will have lunch during this break. Please be aware that pupils will require either a packed lunch or if they wish to do so can purchase during sightseeing.

13.30 – Dance Works studio – step by step workshop on Wicked

15.00 – Travel to hotel – Royal National Hotel, Bedford Way, London (one nights bed/breakfast included)

16.30 – Travel to Hard Rock Café – Food/one drink included (extra money will be needed if further drinks required)

18.30 – Travel to the theatre where we will be watching Wicked!

22.30 – Travel back to the accommodation

Sightseeing:

We will be visiting The Natural History Museum before walking to Westminster/Big Ben, Crossing Westminster Bridge to the London Eye. We will stop for Lunch (**will need to be purchased**) before sightseeing & photo opportunities along the South Bank (This Morning Studio, Tate Modern, St Paul's Cathedral, Army Headquarters). Our final opportunity will be to cross London Bridge and arrive at the Tower of London before our departure home.
