Cultural Visit to Austria's Capital, Vienna 29th June to 3rd July 2020

To build on the success of our residential programme we are offering a trip to Vienna, Austria's capital city during the summer term of 2020. This is open to all pupils currently in Years 5, 6 and 7 and is a fantastic opportunity which will provide the pupils with a valuable cultural experience.

A sample of activities on offer are:

- *Visit to The Natural History Museum in Vienna
- *Vienna Royal Palace Schonbrunn Imperial Tour
- *Day at Prater Park (The world's oldest amusement park)
- *Belvedere Palace Museum
- *Hunderwasser Village, a quirky colourful village built in an apartment block
- *Bowling
- *Guided Tour of Vienna

The price of the trip is £630 which includes coach transfers to and from a UK Airport, flights and travel insurance. Accommodation is offered on a full board basis (breakfast, evening meal and packed lunch for excursions). This price is based on taking 40 pupils. In the event of receiving insufficient numbers we will have no choice but to cancel this trip and refund initial deposits.

Currently all children are eligible to go however pupils who do not meet the behaviour expectations of the school and their teachers will risk losing the opportunity of this wonderful experience.

If you would like your child to be considered for a place on this trip, please make an initial non-refundable deposit of £100 by Friday 6th September 2019 via Parentpay or contact the finance office for a bar coded letter. It is anticipated that this trip will be popular and it may be that the places will be filled before this date. Only once the deposit is paid will a place be held for your child. Please be aware that once the deposit has been paid and your child has been allocated a place, you will be liable for the full balance.

A 2nd deposit of £125 will then be required by 1st November 2019, a 3rd payment of £150 will be required by 7th February 2020, and the balance in full by 6th April 2020. You may make extra payments or the balance in full at any time.
