Dear Parent / Carer

Year 4 to 5 Transition – Kingswood Trust. September 2019 (dates to be confirmed)

Exciting times ahead! As part of your child's transition from their first schools into Codsall Middle School, this year, for the first time, I have arranged to take all the Year 5's to the 'Kingswood Trust' for an outdoor activity day.

Each form will attend with their form tutor and their Year 8 champions. The aim of the day is for the pupils to consolidate new friendships and engage in activities that will support them in becoming resilient young learners.

The pupils will come to school as normal on their allocated day, they will then be transported to Kingswood, arriving at 10.00am and return to school by 3.15pm.

As all activities are outdoors, the children will need to come to school in their own outdoor clothes (they may get wet and muddy so not best clothes!). However, so that they can enjoy working outside in any weathers the centre can provide waterproof coats, trousers and wellies should they be required to complement their own coats.

Your child will also need to bring a packed lunch. This should be in a carrier bag so that all rubbish can be disposed of, no fizzy drinks, glass bottles or sweets. There is a gift shop, subject to availability and time, where there is a selection of souvenir gifts, prices range from £1.50 - £3.00. (Goodie Bag £2.50).

To support the cost of this event, which includes transport on the day, we would request £9 per child. Please find attached a Parentpay activation letter to activate your child's account. Payment is preferably via Parentpay (this will also provide consent) or requesting a Paypoint barcoded letter from the Finance office. Cash will NOT be accepted. Please make payment by Monday 15th July.

If your child is entitled to Free School Meals and you wish school to provide a packed lunch for them, please contact school.

Please complete the attached form, which is a requirement of the centre for health and safety.
