Mobile Phone & Electronic Games Policy

We discourage the presence of mobile phones in Codsall Middle School and do not accept responsibility for phones. Smart Watches should **not** be worn by pupils.

Policy Guidelines:

- Should a parent feel it is necessary for a pupil to have a mobile phone with them, the phone must be handed in during form time in the morning and collected at the end of the day. **The phone must have a sticker with the child's name on it.**
- If a pupil does not comply with this policy and is found with a phone (on or off) it will be confiscated and a parent will need to collect it. The pupil may be banned from bringing a phone indefinitely.

Personal Appearance

At Codsall Middle School a high standard of personal appearance is expected. Pupils need to be proud of their smart uniform which will reflect the business-like and purposeful atmosphere of the school. Skirts and trousers should be appropriate for school and not fashion items.

- Hair should be worn in a simple, neat style with no 'cult' cuts, including 'tramlines'; natural hair colour should be worn during term time.
- Make-up is not permitted (for instance, mascara, eyeliner, blusher, lipstick and coloured nail varnish).
- Jewellery is restricted to one pair of small plain gold/silver ear studs and a wristwatch. Other visible body piercings are not acceptable. Permission may be given to wear other jewellery for religious reasons. We do not accept any responsibility for jewellery brought into school.

Girls' Uniform

- Black Blazer with school logo — compulsory for all pupils
- Grey or black pleated or A-line skirt, pinafore dress or trousers
- White blouse
- School tie
- Sensible black shoes, not trainers, with white, grey or black socks
- Tan or black tights

Optional:

- Mid-blue Gingham Summer dress (Summer term only)
- Grey or black culottes
- Light grey jumper or light grey cardigan both with school logo

We respectfully ask that if a pupil wears a hijab it should be black, white or grey.

Boys' Uniform

- Black Blazer with school logo — compulsory for all pupils
- Dark grey or black trousers
- White shirt
- School tie
- Sensible black shoes, not trainers, with white, grey or black socks

Optional:

- Formal grey or black shorts
- Light grey jumper with school logo

PLEASE NOTE: Neither tube skirts, skin tight leggings, jeans or trainers are acceptable items of uniform and parents will be expected to replace them immediately.

Branded sports trainers are not permitted as school shoes, this includes trainers that have a leather upper appearance.
